Enhanced TOEFL Prep

Enhanced TOEFL Preparation is a 12-hour instructor-guided course for students with intermediate English proficiency (CEFR B1 or higher, or TOEFL > 42) who are actively preparing for the TOEFL iBT (Test of English as a Foreign Language, Internet-Based Test). The first four sessions will include a test overview, strategies and resources for test preparation, test taking strategies and practice exercises for each of the four test sections. The final session will include a mock test experience and a follow-up conference with the instructor to develop a test prep plan.
